

**ORDINANCE 2008-4
TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
OF THE LANARK FIRE
PROTECTION DISTRICT**

ANNUAL TAX LEVY
ORDINANCE OF THE LANARK
FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
OF CARROLL COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 2009

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Lanark Fire Protection District of Carroll County, Illinois, did on the 10th day of July, A.D. 2008 pass the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for said District for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2009, after public hearing was held thereon upon due notice as by law provided, the amount of which is ascertained to be an appropriation in the aggregate sum of SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE AND 00/100 (\$631,131.00) DOLLARS, which Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance was duly published on the 16th day of July, A.D. 2008, in The Prairie Advocate, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Carroll and regularly circulated within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Lanark Fire Protection District of Carroll County, Illinois, did, on the 10th day of September, A.D. 2008, enter a RESOLUTION that the Lanark Fire Protection District in the City of Lanark and County of Carroll adopt a Levy Ordinance for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2008, and ending April 30, 2009. The tentative levy as developed in the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance is less than 105% of the levy which the District made for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2008, and adopted December 12, 2007. In addition, said figure is less than 105% of the levy extended for said fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE LANARK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF CARROLL COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I: That there be and hereby is levied upon all taxable property within the Corporate limits of the Lanark Fire Protection District subject to taxation for the current year, the total sum of FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE AND

00/100 (\$541,131.00) DOLLARS for the following specified purposes mentioned in said Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance and in the respective sums as follows for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2009.

1. ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES

Dues and assessments in Illinois Association of Fire Protection District: Total Appropriation \$891.00; Fire \$552.00; Ambulance \$339.00. Salaries of Trustees and Treasurer, year ending April 30, 2008: Total Appropriation \$2,640.00; Fire \$1,637.00; Ambulance \$1,003.00. Charge to ambulance service for use of support vehicle: Total Appropriation \$-0-; Fire \$-0-; Ambulance \$-0-. For contingent miscellaneous and general unforeseen expenses not included in any items above. Total Appropriations \$8,800.00; Fire \$5,456.00; Ambulance \$3,344.00. TOTAL CONTINGENCY FUND: Total Appropriations \$8,800.00; Fire \$5,456.00; Ambulance \$3,344.00. TOTAL LEVY FOR FIRE PROTECTION PURPOSES:

TOTAL LEVY: \$541,131.00.

SECTION II: That each of said items in the aggregate thereof are deemed necessary by the Board of Trustees of said District to defray the necessary expenses and liability of said district for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2009.

SECTION III: That the Secretary of said District is hereby directed to cause this levy ordinance to be

published in The Prairie Advocate, a public secular newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lanark, Illinois, within said District.

SECTION IV: That the Secretary of said District is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Carroll County, Illinois, as required by law.

SECTION V: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the expiration of ten days from and after publication in accordance by law.
