### Public Meeting Notice

#### Savanna Army Depot Activity Sites 44 and 192 Remedial Action

The U.S. Department of the Army, in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, will host a public meeting to discuss the proposed remedies for Site 44, Nitric Acid Storage, and Site 192, Manganese Ore Storage Mounds, at Savanna Army Depot Activity (SVDA), Illinois. Site 44 was reportedly used to store nitric acid before 1974 and is currently inactive. No action is proposed for Site 44. At Site 192, piles of manganese ore were stored along the SVDA railroad tracks in the CF Plant area. Excavation and off-

site disposal are proposed for Site 192 to achieve remediation goals. The community is invited to provide comments and attend a meeting to discuss the Proposed Plans for these sites.
